A tool for public decision-makers, international bodies, and investors

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In 2018, the European Commission in its Report titled

Measuring Public Administration: A Feasibility study for better comparative indicators in the EU

stated:

"Good governance and the quality of public administrations are recognizably in the interest of EU citizens and Member States, to achieve maximum value from finite public funds (...). Worldwide, the evidence is irrefutable: high productivity, high income per head economies have the most effective and efficient public institutions".

WHY IS ADMINISTRATIVE CAPACITY CRUCIAL?

There can be economic and social development only with an effective ADMINISTRATIVE CAPACITY

Money is not sufficient to guarantee a good public governance:

Without well-performing public governance, European funds for recovery and resilience risk to be wasted.

Funds would be as an *injection of petrol in a car with a* broken engine

Member States need to perform a sort of **due diligence of their administrative machinery** at central and local level.



1. AN ASSESSMENT METHOD IS ESSENTIAL

Assessment is not aimed at grading or ranking Administrations, but to:

- □ **Map administrative capacity** at national and local level;
- Develop a targeted improvement plan.

HOW TO ACHIEVE A GOOD ADMINISTRATIVE CAPACITY?

2. ASSESSMENT REQUIRES DATA

Which kind of data?

Economic and financial data are not sufficient.

Qualitative data are equally essential: e.g., public service delivery, annual goals, attention to social accountability or civic engagement, and so on.



HOW TO OBTAIN THAT KIND OF DATA?

AN INNOVATIVE ASSESSMENT METHOD

To **measure** administrative capacity To develop a targeted support to improve administrative capacity To **compare** transparency, efficiency and integrity To monitor chronological trend To provide alerts on default and corruption risks



AN INNOVATIVE DIAGNOSTIC METHOD

- It is a quantitative and qualitative index,
- based on objective data,
- already published by PAs.

Its method is based on the **ESG sustainability indexes**, used in financial markets.

IN THE EU MEMBER STATES

Public Administration systems differ largely one State from another, but they all have the same function: to serve the community.

EU States adopted a law on transparency and right to access public information:

Freedom of Information Act

Sometimes, the national legislator has **advocated for the right of access** and **overlooked the duty of direct publication**:

in these cases, the second pillar is weak, only representing a **generic obligation** to publish.





We have been entrusted by the **European Commission** – **DG Regio** with a **Pilot project** to test our Index in a sample of EU Member States.

Results show that our Index is applicable and useful for the assessment of public governance in different EU Member States.

We built an evaluation grid, selecting indicators common to the Countries analyzed.

- Some indicators are **very basic**, in order not to be too severe towards those countries which lack accountability,

- Some indicators are **more ambitious**, in order to recognize the effort of more advanced countries, such as Spain.

ITALY

Italy approved an **excellent law** on transparency in 2013, similarly to Spain.

The result is that today **transparency is not a problem** in Italy.

It is not what perception-based indexes suggest;

nonetheless, **the facts say** that Italian PAs publish large amounts of data.

For over a decade we have been regularly assessing the administrative capacity of Regions and Municipalities in Italy,


And also detecting their strengths and weaknesses.

The results of our analysis say that

- no Region or Municipality is the best in all indicators;

- no Region or Municipalities is the worst in all indicators.

At year end, 60 of 86 projects were completed or on track, 13 had a minor delivery issue and 10 had a significant delivery issue, while 3 were replaced, deferred or amalgamated. In terms of the delayed projects, those with a significant delivery issue are projects that have missed or are expected to miss the expected timeframe for completion by 3 months or more.

Minor Delivery Issue means that there has been an over-run of less than 3 months at report date

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
